

Coat Hanger Book Report

Due: Wednesday, January 23, 2008

Please do not turn your project in any earlier than the due date. ☺

Pick out a good 2nd grade level reading book. Read the story. Find out who the main character of the story is and create a coat hanger person. Fill out the information on the paper bow tie. The bow tie needs to be on your coat hanger character.

You may use some of the recommended reading lists I gave you earlier this year, if you need some ideas on good literature or visit the public library.

Be creative and take your time on designing the main character!

COAT HANGER CHARACTERS

Transform wire coat hangers into clever character displays. To make a character; a student bends a coat hanger into a desired shape and stretches a nylon over the hanger, pulling it toward the hook of the hanger. At the base of the hook, the student secures the stocking with a piece of yarn. Next, cut craft materials- such as yarn, felt, and fabric to create facial features to resemble a character from a chosen book. Then glue features to the stocking. For a final touch, complete the paper bow with information about the book's main character. Glue the bow onto the project. Students will be presenting their projects to the class.
