Monday - Door Decoration

Preparation for Monday will be on Friday, May 2nd, after school until 7pm. Students and Parents need to prepare items to be attached to the classroom doors by Friday. Room parents and any other volunteers or students that would like to participate, will decorate the doors on Friday (the last day of the previous week).

Tuesday – Fruit Baskets

Each student needs to bring 1 seasonal fruit for each of their teachers. Each teacher will need to have a basket for the fruit to be placed in their classrooms on Tuesday morning.

Wednesday – Teacher Luncheon

Each classroom needs to collectively create 1 placemat for each of their teachers. Students need to work with room parents to complete their teachers' placemats by Friday, May 2. Use 11x17 construction paper or buy a placemat. The placemats will be laminated and given to the teachers on Wednesday at their luncheon. Room Moms are to encourage parents to bring Pot Luck dishes for the Luncheon.

Thursday – Flower Day

Students are to bring 1 flower in for each of their teachers; flowers can be bought or picked from their homes. There will need to be vases filled with water in each classroom for students to put the flowers in, as they enter their classrooms on Thursday morning.

If students wish to create a poem, story or picture about their teacher, they may give it to their teachers on Thursday if they like. Students may provide their poem, story or picture on any 8 ½ x 11 paper.
